Easton College Farm Trip

As part of our forthcoming topic 'From Field to Fork', we are very much looking forward to visiting Easton College Farm on Tuesday 27th September. We will be leaving school at 8.45am (following a safety briefing) and will return to school in time for Stop and Collect. During the visit we will be exploring the Farm (including a visit to the dairy) and will try our hands at felt-making, churning butter, extracting oil and grinding wheat. All children will be provided with a picnic lunch (with special dietary requirements being catered for).

Please can your child bring the following (if they are not already at school):

The journey will be approximately thirty minutes by coach so please let us know (either in person or by emailing Mrs Stackwood) if your child has ever experienced travel sickness so that we can sit them at the front of the coach.
