Year 8 trip to Norwich Salvation Army Citadel Meeting

You may recall that in Year 7 your child visited Norwich Salvation Army Citadel and Catherine's Coffee Lounge as part of their Religious Studies Common Entrance course. Following the trip, the children started working on their Common Entrance Project, which is eventually sent on to their future school for marking and consideration as part of their Common Entrance exam.
