



Year 1 Curriculum Information

Week Beginning 23rd January 2017

Dear Parents

In assembly this week, Mrs Harries talked to the children about the idea of happiness and kindness, with the help of the *Mr Men*, followed by a story from the Bible about Jesus being invited to a party. During our weekly Bird Family meetings, the children thought about their worries and fears and we suggested ways in which these can be solved and shared. We enjoyed meeting the 'Worry Monsters' once again, which are characters from our charity, Nelson's Journey.

Literacy

The children have all been working extremely hard and we have noticed a large improvement in handwriting this week. Mr Fereday's group have been learning 'air' 'it's not fair' and reading a story about making pizza. Both Mr Fereday and Mrs Wilson's groups have been focusing on using time sequencing words in their writing (first, next, then, finally). Mrs Wilson's group also learned how to spell words with 'a-e' 'make a cake'. Mr Fisher's group have been learning 'ir' 'whirl and twirl' and were writing in the 'first person', portraying different characters.

Numeracy

The children have been learning how to write 2 and 3-digit numbers on whiteboards. They have used the hundred squares to help with subtraction, and some children have been practising subtracting 10 from any given number up to 100, in their heads. They have also been revising number bonds to 10 and 20 and applying their knowledge to missing number sums, eg $7 + ? = 17 + ? =$

Other lessons and activities:

- In art, the children celebrated Chinese New Year. They completed a carousel of different art and craft activities with each of the Year 1 teachers. They have made lanterns, fans and even had a go at some Chinese character writing.
- In topic, we have been learning about the countries that form the United Kingdom. We learned about their flags and traditions and located them on a map.
- The children have learned how to complete various activities to help sustain their level of fitness. They are learning to identify which part of their body they are exercising (trunk, lower body or upper body).

Over the weekend your child might like to:

- Complete the handwriting and spelling book work.
- Play Rainy Daze, which has been allocated on Active Learn.
