On Friday 24th February Year 4 children will be visiting Sutton Hoo as part of their current history topic on the Anglo-Saxons. We will be travelling to and from the venue by coach. Whilst there we will receive a guided tour of the burial mounds, an explanation of the treasures found, explore the exhibition at the site and carry out an archaeological detectives activity.
