

Nursery Curriculum Information

Dear Parents

We have had a very busy week in Nursery. We have celebrated Pancake Day and World Book Day and had a visit from Tesco. Our key text has been 'The Runaway Pancake' and our new phonic sound has been "I" for Lydia, lemon and lollipop.

- On Monday, we enjoyed our dance session with Mrs Wilson. We read our new key text 'The Runaway Pancake' and talked about the different ingredients we would need to buy to make our own pancakes. Mrs Hampsheir wrote a shopping list on the whiteboard. Lots of the children practised writing numerals to 10 correctly. We explored cornflakes and 2D shapes in the texture tray.
- On Tuesday, we all shared some of our weekend news with a grown up. We had lots of fun playing with yellow play dough and frying pans in Nursery and practised flipping real pancakes outside using tennis rackets. We had lots of fun playing games and travelling in different ways in the sports hall. In the afternoon we made our own pancakes and ate them with a variety of different toppings.
- On Wednesday, we enjoyed our music sessions with Miss Skinner and sang lollipop songs linked to our new sound "I". We had a lovely time in the Pre Prep hall in the morning, learning about 5 different types of bread and 5 different fruits from around the world. Lots of the children really enjoyed tasting the different breads and fruits.
- On Thursday, we all went swimming in small groups. We had lots of fun attending assembly and seeing all the Pre Prep children dressed up in their World Book Day costumes. The children really enjoyed being dressed up as lots of different characters. We explored gloop in the texture tray. We read lots of stories linked to our World Book costumes.
- On Friday we enjoyed many different activities in Nursery. A large group chose to participate in our weekly yoga activity in the Pre Prep hall after morning snack. Lots of the children painted a variety of different pictures with Mrs Bloom. We went for a lovely walk through the woods and talked about the names of the different spring flowers that we found.
