Year 2 Trip to Pensthorpe Natural Reserve

We are very much looking forward to visiting Pensthorpe Natural Reserve near Fakenham on Friday 12th May. We will be leaving school at 9.00am (following a safety briefing) and will return to school in time for 'stop and collect'.

During the visit we will be exploring a variety of natural habitats and learning more about some of the living things which can be found in them. We will also be meeting a barn owl and learning more about some of the endangered species which are part of Pensthorpe's conservation work. After lunch there will be a chance for the children to experience 'Wild Rootz'.

Please use the checklist below to help ensure that your child is fully equipped to have an enjoyable and educational day.

Please can your child bring the following (if they are not already at school):

- A named sunhat - if possible, this should be a Town Close regulation hat but children can wear a suitable dark hat if you are waiting for a replacement to arrive
- A named PE bag - ideally this will be their blue school rucksack
- Navy jogging bottoms
- Navy waterproof – a lightweight jacket if you have one
- White PE top
- Please apply sun cream before coming to school

The journey will be approximately an hour by coach so please let us know (either in person or by emailing Mrs Stackwood) if your child has ever experienced travel sickness, so that we can sit them at the front of the coach. Please also let us know if they have taken any anti-sickness tablets and, if your child suffers from hay fever, please ensure that they have had an anti-histamine before coming to school.

We look forward to a super trip and we are sure you will hear all about it!
