We have enjoyed busy days in school this week! Our Bird Family meeting was all about talents, talking about children's own talents and those of their peers. We enjoyed a lovely celebration of achievements in our Pre Prep assembly earlier today.

We were so impressed with the performance the children gave in our end of year assembly. Their confidence and self-control helped us to realise just how far they have all come during their year in Reception.

Thank you for supporting the children again later in the week and cheering them on as they rose to the challenge of racing, balancing a bean bag, collecting water and walking with an egg and spoon, during our sports afternoon. We are very proud of their teamwork and effort.

On Tuesday, we all went for a walk in the woods and were intrigued by a whistling sound coming through the trees. Convinced it was a bird we followed the sound and discovered, to our great surprise, a nest full of eggs!
