Dear Parents

It has been wonderful to begin getting to know your children and we are very impressed with the enthusiasm and maturity that they have shown during their first three days in Year 1. Alongside getting to know our new class friends and teachers, we have been busy doing the following:

- Writing about our summer holiday news
- Counting to twenty and ordering numbers correctly
- Forming our numerals correctly
- Drawing a self-portrait using a range of media
- Playing circle games and having class discussions
- Enjoying choosing time both in our new classroom and outside
- Making a birthday card. We will put these in a class box and when it is someone's birthday they get to pick a 'lucky dip' card from the box
- Exploring the Year 1 Computer Room

In assembly, we welcomed new pupils and staff and talked about all the changes that have taken place in Pre Prep over the summer holiday. We talked about playground safety and the Town Close Way, thinking about ways in which we celebrate and support each other, as well as looking after ourselves, our friends and our school. We also discussed Bird Families and the fact that we are adding a new family this year, Peregrines, in order to keep our groupings to a size which maximises opportunities for children to share their ideas amongst the group.
