



## Year 2 Curriculum information

Week Beginning: 29 January 2018

Dear Parents

In Bird Family meetings this week the subject was worries and mindfulness. The 'worry eaters' that children had been introduced to via last year's charity, 'Nelson's Journey' were re-introduced to children, as well as talking about mindfulness and how to manage feelings of worry or anxiety. In assembly, as part of Storytelling Week and in preparation for World Book Day in March, Mrs Harries shared one of her favourite childhood stories, Mr Tickle by Roger Hargreaves, with the children. We also talked about the fact that Mr Tickle needed to understand that if someone didn't like being tickled, they could ask him to stop, and that he should do so straight away!

Following the story, Mrs Harries set the children a challenge! This is completely optional, but something we hope will appeal to children across the Pre Prep. They have been asked to invent a new Mr Men or Little Miss character and to tell their story, or to write a new story for a current character. We will be presenting prizes for the winning entries on World Book Day (more details to follow).

### Literacy Lessons

- In word-building lessons, we have explored adding 'er' to create a comparative adjective meaning 'more'.
- In spellings we have familiarised ourselves with language linked to our topic of 'The Great Fire of London'.
- We have listened to a range of stories and recounts of events linked to the Great Fire.
- We have written questions for Samuel Pepys and extracted information from his historical diaries.

### Maths Lessons

- We have revisited 3D shape and secured our knowledge of the properties of these.
- We have explored pattern and continued patterns.
- We have revisited o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past times.

### Other Lessons

- We have explored adding water to materials; making predictions and then observing change and recording our findings.
- We made our own Tudor houses in readiness for staging our own 'Great Fire' next week.
