Goodnight Mister Tom

As the senior production of 'Goodnight Mister Tom' draws nearer, I wanted to notify you of the arrangements for the two performance evenings, Thursday 8th and Friday 9th March.

Children are invited to remain in school where they will be supervised (homework or a film 4pm – 5pm) and fed a two course hot dinner (5pm) before preparing for the show (costume, make-up and warm-up 5.30pm). If your child is unable to stay at school during this time, please inform me so that I can keep a record of who to expect and please ensure they are back in school well before 6pm on both evenings.

Tickets will be available to book, free-of-charge, on the School's website and a separate letter will be sent out with further information. Please note that, whilst the vast majority of the cast will perform the same role on both evenings, some of the lead roles have been double-cast. Therefore, some children will only be performing their main role on one evening, becoming part of the ensemble for the other performance. These roles are: Mr Tom, William, Mrs Beech and Zach. Please check with your child or contact me if you are unsure which evening they will be performing. You are, of course, very welcome to attend both performances and see the two interpretations of the script, but you may also wish to book your preferred night.

I would also like to thank you for all of your support with rehearsals and costumes. It really does mean a lot to the children and to me.
