IAPS Mini-Hockey National Finals

We are most looking forward to participating in the IAPS mini-hockey national finals. Please find below information regarding the tournament, which I hope you find useful.

Before the Tournament

We were unable to secure a fixture this weekend for training, as Dereham HC have their own Alex Hill memorial tournament and most of the boys will be playing in that. Therefore, we will have an attacking short corner practice at GOALS after school on Monday 19th March. We will leave school as close to 4.10pm as possible, so the children involved will need to change into their games kit at lunch time. They can either be collected from the Astro at 4.50pm or back at school at 5.00pm. Please note that any children who have not been collected will be taken back to school for 5.00pm. Plate competition too. Please be aware, therefore, that everyone is not guaranteed pitch time during every game, though everyone should have had a good amount of pitch time by the end of the day. Do speak to me if you have any concerns about this or would rather your child did not come along if they are not likely to play in every match.

Finally, this event is a reward for all the hard work that these young players have put into their game, not just this year, but over the last 4 or 5 years. They will value your support and will wish to impress you. Please refrain from criticising or coaching from the sides as per the attached IAPS 'Code of Conduct' for spectators.
