Dear Parents

As part of our Geography topic on Coasts, Year 4 will be visiting Cromer and West Runton on Monday 16th April. Whilst there, they will explore the features of a coastal town and will take part in fossil finding and rock pooling activities organised by the Norfolk Wildlife Trust.

The children will be departing from school at approximately 8.50am and will return to school by 4.00pm. We will be travelling by coach. As the journey is around 1 hour, they may bring in something to occupy themselves on the journey (e.g. top trumps, colouring etc.) but we ask that no electronic items be brought into school for this trip.

Due to the nature of the activities, they will need to come dressed in comfortable, old clothes suitable for the weather conditions on the day (no jeans or skirts). They will need to come to school in a pair of trainers for the morning session and will need to bring wellies or old trainers for the afternoon activities (no Crocs) in a clearly named, waterproof bag. They will need a second set of clothes, in the unlikely event that they get wet. Finally, they will need to bring in a rucksack which is large enough to hold their extra set of clothes, a clipboard and something to write with. School can provide clipboards if needed.

A packed lunch will be provided by the School (please bring a separate box for this to be placed inside their rucksack) and the children can also bring up to £2 for an ice-cream in a named purse or wallet (weather permitting). Please note, children will be responsible for any money brought on the trip.
