**Sailing Club**

As a pupil in Years 5 to 8, your son/daughter has the opportunity to join Sailing Club on Thursday evenings this term from 4.15pm to 6.15pm. There are limited places for this activity and it is often oversubscribed. Therefore, children wishing to take part will need to be selected at random using the random name selector App **(on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2018)**. Please sign the consent form below if you agree with the details of this letter. If selected, the cost of the course is £72.00 and I would be grateful if the School could have payment once the selection process has taken place and before the children begin the course on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May. The sessions are Thursdays: 17<sup>th</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> May, 7<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> June and 5<sup>th</sup> July 2018.

The children will need:

- 2 sets of casual clothes, including underwear
- a large towel
- an old pair of trainers (which will get wet and muddy)
- sun cream
- safety cord for glasses/sun glasses
- hat

The sessions will be taken by qualified instructors who are based at Whitlingham Broad, Trowse. The children will be travelling by minibus, which should return to Town Close at approximately 6.30pm. Should you wish to collect your child from Whitlingham Broad itself, please be there by 6:05pm. Car park fees are applicable at Whitlingham Country Park. Customers of the centre have a 10 minute period of grace to pick up participants. Anyone parking for longer than 10 minutes will need to pay fees as detailed on the signs in the car parks.
