



Year 4 Horstead Residential Visit 2018: Some Final Reminders

1. **Please wear suitable home clothes** to school on Wednesday 6th June.
2. **Please pack your bags carefully using the kit list.** You must be able to fit everything you bring in one bag and you should be able to carry it yourself. Clothes should be suitable for the weather and for outdoor activities: long sleeves and trousers are compulsory for the activities. No new or favourite clothes please. Please remember to pack a pair of indoor shoes and two pairs for outside.
3. **Please bring sun protection.** A sun hat, sun cream and sunglasses would help to protect you from the sun. You may also want to bring a refillable drinks bottle.
4. **Name everything!** Please make sure that everything you bring has your name on it. Pack a plastic/bin bag for dirty/muddy clothes to be returned home in.
5. **Please do not bring valuables**, such as: electronic games, digital cameras, iPods, jewellery or mobile phones.
6. **Please do not bring any food, sweets or drinks** (unless prearranged for medical reasons).
7. **Remember to hand in your labelled medication to Miss Goddard on Wednesday.** She will be in the **Library between 8.20am and 9.00am** to collect and log-in any medication (*this has changed from the time printed in the original booklet you received*).
8. **Please bring a reading book and cuddly toy** with you. Your teachers will be bringing theirs!
9. **Practise making sandwiches before you come.** Remember, you will be making your own lunches at Horstead!
10. **To contact us in an emergency please ring 07747 051140.** We will contact you immediately should the need arise and we will check the school mobile phone regularly.
11. **Children will be ready for collection at 4.00pm on Friday 8th June**, as they will return to Town Close School during the afternoon and before the end of the school day.
12. **Please bring a maximum of £5 for the souvenir shop in a named wallet or purse**, should you wish to buy something to remember the visit. Coins are best!
