Year 5 Visit to Duxford

I write with details of the Year 5 visit to Duxford Aerodrome on Friday 8th June. The home of a major Imperial War Museum collection, Duxford is a marvellous venue to enrich the children's studies in DT and history. More about the museum can be found by visiting their [website](#).

We will travel by coach, leaving the School at **8.30am** and returning by **3.30pm**. Packed lunches and snacks will be provided by the School. Pupils will need to be in uniform and to bring a raincoat and a small rucksack (or similar) to carry their lunch on arrival. The cost of the visit will be met by the School.

Pupils may bring a notebook, card games etc. for the journey, but no electronic devices (including mobile phones) should be brought. Pupils will be entirely responsible for their own possessions. They can bring pocket money (£5 will suffice; certainly not more than £10 please) to spend in the shop if they wish; this must be in a named purse or wallet.

Duxford was used by the RAF from 1918 onwards, finding fame later on as a major venue for the filming of *The Battle of Britain* and *Memphis Belle*.

In order that we arrive on time for the first workshop, we need to depart promptly at 8.30am. Please contact me at school if you have any queries.
