**The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe - Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> and Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June  
Dress rehearsal - Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June 10-2pm  
Arrangements for the evenings of the performance, costume plea**

On the evenings of the Year 6 performances, we will make provision at school for the children to have tea, do their prep and prepare for the evening ahead. We would expect the children to stay at school, but if you would like to take your child home before the performance, please let me know by email, and ensure your child is returned to school by 6pm. The children need to be present for both performances.

Whilst many of the cast have already done so, may I please now ask that **all** bring in their costume and, where necessary, drama blacks in a named plastic bag on a coat-hanger, as soon as possible. We have sourced a number of individual costumes but all boys will need a pair of black jeans and a long sleeved black top (without motifs) and girls will need black leggings and a long sleeved black top. Any additional costumes will be worn over these basics.

I would also remind you that there will be a full run through and dress rehearsal on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June from 10 - 2 pm. If this is a problem (I am aware of a football memorial match for example), please let me know by email. This said, it has been an incredibly busy time of the year at school and impossible to run any number of scenes with a full cast present, let alone twice with both casts. So, I would really appreciate full commitment where at all possible.

Finally, it is clear that many of the cast have yet to learn their lines, which has also hindered smooth rehearsals and running of scenes. I would therefore be grateful if you could encourage, support and practise with them.
