Dear Parents

For those of you who are intending to watch the School Charity Triathlon on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June, I hope that the attached timetable proves useful. As you can see it is going to be a very busy day!

The children in the Pre Prep will be swimming in their ability groups and running and triking in their form groups. Those in Years 3 and 4 will be taking part in their form groups for all three activities and the children in Years 5 to 8 will be in their tutor groups with two groups together at the same time.

Parents are, of course, welcome to stay for as long as they wish to watch the children participating. Please ensure though that you are wearing your parent badges.

As mentioned in the previous letter Ronaldo's Ices will be present from 1.30pm and tea/coffee will be available at certain times during the day. The PTA has kindly offered to run a Cake Stall during the day as well.

The Year 8 pupils will be running some fete type stalls, including speed stacking and a coconut shy, throughout the day for the younger children to spend their time and money affording them the opportunity to have fun and, in some cases, win prizes. The children will also have the opportunity to take part in other fun based activities, which will take place on the front lawn outside the main house. Your child will, therefore, require some pocket money for the day.

Parents of Pre Prep children are welcome to collect their child once all their events are completed and are also invited to take them to buy an ice cream and to participate in the events on the front lawn; £2 will allow children to have a go at all the activities organised by the Year 8 pupils.
