Year 6 Religious Studies trip to Walsingham

As part of our Religious Studies curriculum we will be visiting Walsingham on **Thursday 20th September**, to take part in a church trail day. The children will be visiting the Methodist, Roman Catholic, Orthodox Churches and the Anglican Shrine. They will have opportunities to compare and explore the different sites, seeing at first-hand how different denominations organise themselves.

We will be leaving school at 8.30am promptly and returning in time for the end of the day. Please ensure your child is in school by 8.15am and goes straight to the library. Mrs Rymarz, Mr Buck and Mr Flatt will be accompanying us on the trip. A school packed lunch will be provided for the children. However, as you will have seen in the Headmaster's first newsletter of the term your child will need to bring their own named water bottle with them on the trip. There will be a chance to refill this at one point in the day, should there be the need. There will be opportunities to browse around the shrine gift shop, so a small amount of pocket money might be useful.

I would ask you to ensure your child has a school waterproof coat in school, just in case, as we will be spending some time walking around the village in between the different sites. In addition, if your child is asthmatic can you please ensure that they have a suitable inhaler with them.
