F24 Event at Rockingham Motor Speedway

I write with details of the F24 event at Rockingham Motor Speedway on **Friday 5th October**. Minibus transport will be provided by the School, **leaving promptly from the main drive at 6.15am** as scrutineering of the racing cars starts at 8.30am. **We expect to return at 4.30pm**, but will take contact details and endeavour to let you know if this changes.

School will provide a packed lunch and snacks. If they wish, pupils may bring pocket money to buy extra refreshments at the event. They must bring a named water bottle, please.

Pupils who are driving will be lent racing overalls. We will provide helmets and gloves; pupils may bring their own but anything they bring will be their own responsibility. Please check forecasts as we will be outside for part of the day and racing will continue if it rains. If the forecast is sunny, drivers will need sunglasses. Non-drivers should wear TCH polo shirt, TCH hoodie, fleece or games top, jeans & trainers.

Pupils may bring items to entertain themselves on the minibus, such as books, notepads etc. Any mobile phones must be handed in before we leave Town Close but would be handed back if time allows the children to go to the café, or if they are needed to contact parents on the journey home.

Town Close will compete in the **11.30am – 13.00pm race**. There is catering at the venue; alternately anyone attending might want to bring a chair and their own refreshments.
