

Nursery Curriculum Information

Week Beginning: Monday 1st October 2018

Dear Parents

This week in Nursery we have been talking about 'being helpful', linked to our special story *The Very Helpful Hedgehog*. We have talked about the number 4, squares and rectangles. We will begin to assess the children's knowledge of phonic sounds next week and to start to introduce the letter sounds.

- On Monday, the children all had dance with Mrs Wilson. We read *The Very Helpful Hedgehog* and cut an apple into 4 pieces or quarters. Some of the children created leaf print pictures. We went for a walk through the woods, and noticed how many leaves are on the ground now. We found the cottage that Goldilocks lived in a long time ago and the cottage that the three bears used to live in on either side of our school woods.
- On Tuesday, the children joined in to sing our special number 4 song and all
 went swimming. Lots of the children created salt dough hedgehogs. We had a
 lovely time playing outside in the garden and on the Pre Prep playground in the
 wind. We watched the old television adverts whereby the little hedgehog learns
 how to cross the road safely, and talked about remembering to 'Stop, Look and
 Listen'.
- On Wednesday, the children listened carefully to instructions to play some new circle games. In the afternoon, we went to the music room and used different percussion instruments to sing songs with Miss Skinner. Lots of the children painted with Mrs Bloom. Some of the children played a simple shape game with a grown up, and made marks. Some children were able to recognise some of the letters in their name.
- On Thursday, we read our special story again and talked about being helpful.
 We watched Come Outside, which was all about hedgehogs, and talked about 'h' for hedgehog. Some of the children went to music with Miss Skinner and the children really enjoyed making their own leaf crowns.
- On Friday, we had a space themed morning after our exciting visit to the Planetarium. We talked about how to look after our planet and loved having a picnic lunch in Nursery. We read *The Very Helpful Hedgehog* and had a lovely time in the afternoon printing pictures using apples.

This weekend you may like to:

Look for and talk about the number 4; we talked about the number 4 this week at Nursery and have linked this to learning about squares and rectangles having 4 straight sides and 4 corners. You may wish to practise drawing straight lines, curved lines, zig-zags and even some 2D shapes this weekend.
