The Girls

- Girls wore calf-length, long sleeved plain dresses, over which they wear a plain smock. The smock is to keep their dress clean.
- They wear long black socks and black ankle boots.
- Hair is worn off the face and long hair tied back with ribbons.
- A beret or straw hat was always worn when going out.

The Boys

- The boys are wearing breeches - short trousers that come just below the knee,
- Long socks and black ankle boots.
- Shirts had big collars and are worn under a tight fitting jacket. All the buttons would be done up.
- Caps were always worn when going outside.
