We are looking forward to seeing you on Thursday 31st January to discuss the progress your son or daughter has made academically in Year 3. Parking will be available in the Newmarket Road car park and on the main drive.

Appointment slots can be booked online by selecting the Parents' Booking System link in the Parent Information Centre. Please then log in using your email address and password, select the Parents' Evening button and simply click any available slot next to the time you require and your child's name will be inserted into the list. If you change your mind about your chosen time you can simply choose another 'book' button and your child's name will move to that time.

The appointment slot you choose will be with your child's form teacher and we shall make every effort to keep to the time you have booked. All other teachers will be gathered in the **Read Hall** from 5.00pm so you will be able to see them either just before, or just after, your appointment time and this is an ideal opportunity to put names to faces so that future contact will be easier. With regard to mathematics, your child's form teacher will comment on progress for those in either Mr Avenal or Miss Stewart-Pond's sets. Mr Lawry and Mrs Wilcox will be available during the evening to speak to you if your child is in their set.

Parents can help by keeping to the allotted length of time, to prevent over-running. Should a longer discussion be necessary for any reason, you would be most welcome to make a further appointment at a mutually convenient time.
