## Appendix 3 - Dealing with Cystic Fibrosis

Town Close School will:

- welcome pupils with cystic fibrosis;
- encourage and help children with cystic fibrosis to participate fully in school life;
- recognise the need for a high fat, high calorie diet to maintain healthy weight to help children fight infections. We will encourage children to finish snacks and meals;
- ensure all medications are taken at the appropriate time;
- ensure all relevant staff are aware of care plans;
- ensure that any adjustments can be made, regarding access to the curriculum and school activities.

On entry, parents of pupils with cystic fibrosis are asked to inform staff how we can support their child during school hours. A meeting with the child's class teacher is arranged. A Care Plan is written, and signed by the parent and this is displayed in the Staff Common Room. This details the medication needed and the equipment needed for that child.
