IAPS National Hockey Finals – Tuesday 19th March 2019
Millfield School, Street, Somerset BA16 0YD

After a great performance by the boys in the East Finals in Cambridge, the Town Close team has now qualified for the National Finals, which take place at Millfield School on Tuesday 19th March.

As it is such a long journey, we will be travelling to Millfield School on Monday 18th March, leaving Town Close shortly after lunch. We will travel by minibus and aim to arrive at the hotel in time for the boys to have an evening meal. We are staying at the Wookey Hole Hotel, The Mill, Wookey Hole, Wells, Somerset BA5 1BB and Mr Phoenix and I will be accompanying the boys for the trip.

The tournament is due to finish at approximately 4.30pm so I anticipate our arrival time back at Town Close to be in the region of 10.30pm. If there is a significant change to this time, we will contact you en route. The timetable for the matches is attached to this letter. Your son will require some money for the meal on the Monday evening, likely to be about £10, but food will be provided by the School for Tuesday and for the journey home. I will have a school mobile phone with me for the trip should you wish to contact me. The number is 07780 816203.

The boys will not need to be in school uniform on the Monday morning and may wear casual clothes for lessons and the journey. They will need to wear their hoodie which has been purchased especially for the finals. They will also require their full games kit, including several layers, in case of inclement weather. The large School Sports Coats will be issued to the boys before the start of the tournament, as will team shirts and socks.

The boys will also require overnight gear, including a wash bag. Mobile phones/electronic devices should not be brought. Any phones on pupils' possession will need to be handed in at the start of the journey, as per usual school policy.

I would be grateful if you could fill in the attached medical forms and return them to the front office by this Friday. Should the boys require any medication for the trip, they must hand it in to me before setting off.
