Consent for Educational Visits

We place a high value on educational visits for our pupils at Town Close and regard learning outside the classroom to be an essential component of our curriculum, offering opportunities which cannot be provided on site.

For the majority of trips we do not need specific permission for your child to attend, as these visits form part of the curriculum and occur within normal school hours. When this is the case, we will notify you of planned trips and off-site activities, providing you with as much notice as possible.

We do, however, require your specific written consent for more complex visits. These might include trips that extend beyond the normal school day, involve travelling a significant distance or require an extra payment from you. To simplify this process, we intend to collect your 'blanket consent' for all trips via the attached form. This will enable you to provide sufficient permission for your son or daughter to attend all educational visits during their time at the School, without needing to complete a new consent form each time.

Please would be kind enough to complete the attached form and return it to either your child's form teacher or to the School Office by Friday 22nd March.
