## Rehearsal Schedule

We are into an important and very busy part of the rehearsal stretch. So far, we have been really impressed by your commitment to attend rehearsals, make suggestions and dedication to learn lines. Whilst we have yet to rehearse a number of scenes, this term is when the play really comes together and the hard work really begins.

The performance dates are Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> and Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June, which gives us just 6 more weeks to rehearse and refine our Y6 masterpiece. With that in mind, we require complete dedication from everyone and full attendance at all rehearsals for which you are listed. Remember, if you are unable to attend one, you must tell either Miss Basey or Mrs Chitty in advance (at least 24hours if possible).

Please note the Saturday dress rehearsal on 15<sup>th</sup> June from 10-1. It might be inconvenient, but it will make all the difference to the play to have this extra, uninterrupted rehearsal immediately prior to the show week.

We have planned the rehearsal schedule in as much detail as possible at this stage, but as we get closer to the performance dates, some things may change; it is very important that you keep checking the board outside Mrs Chitty's room and looking out for Firefly notifications. We will do everything we can to keep you informed but please also take responsibility for organising yourself too.

***Tuesday lunchtime*** – running scenes with speaking characters

***Thursdays after school*** – full cast every week please (even if you are not in the scene, you will have the opportunity to run lines with others in your scene)

***Friday lunchtime*** – a clinic for Oompa Loompa's and other catch-ups – to be confirmed weekly exactly which scene; we are aware there are fixtures.

## Costumes

In order for you to take ownership of your character, I would like you to help me create your own costumes. I have listed roughly what you will need below. Please collect these as soon as you can and bring them in to school so we can keep them in the Read Hall all ready to go. School will provide or Mrs Copping will make as much as is required. If you have trouble finding any items, let me know and we will sort something. Hi-lighted items we should be able to source at school.

Charity shops are good places to source items, or amazon or Primark.

Narrators – not sure – but you all need to look the same with a subtle difference – perhaps blue jeans, shirts, <b>different coloured bow ties and braces</b> and top hats
Willy Wonka – black trousers, shirt, shiny shoes or boots, <b>waistcoat, cane, long coat and top hat – worn by all</b>
Augustus Gloop – stripy jumper/t-shirt, blue jeans turned up at bottom, trainers
Veruca Salt – spoilt child – matching tracksuit, puffa jacket, trainers
Mike Teavee – your World Book Day costume was perfect!
Violet Beauregarde – gum chewer – tights, shiny patent shoes, <b>short dress or skirt and shirt,</b>
Charlie Bucket – <b>shirt, jumper,</b> brown corduroy trousers, <b>scarf, hat</b>
Mr Bucket – shirt, trousers, jacket, slippers
Mrs Bucket – <b>old fashioned dress,</b> tights, slippers
Grandma Josephine – cotton nightdress, <b>hat,</b> shawl
Grandma Georgina – cotton nightdress, grey hair
Grandpa Joe – night-shirt or long shirt, white long johns, then in factory – brown trousers, <b>tweed jacket, flat cap, neckerchief, shirt</b>
Grandpa George – pyjamas, <b>dressing gown, glasses</b>
Mr Teavee – jeans and bomber jacket
Mrs Teavee – short skirt, <b>coat, silk type shirt</b>
Mr Salt – <b>trilby hat,</b> long coat, trousers, shirt, briefcase
Mrs Salt – fur coat, dress, high heels, American tan tights, neck scarf
Mrs Beauregarde – older version of Violet – tracksuit, puffa jacket, rucksack
Mrs Gloop – old fashioned dress, handbag, heeled shoes, <b>mackintosh style coat</b>
