Year One Trip to BeWILDerwood

We are very much looking forward to visiting BeWILDerwood on Wednesday 22nd May. We will be leaving school at around 9:15am (following a safety briefing) and we will be returning to school in time for 'Stop and Collect'.

The school trip is designed to enhance our science topic of 'Growing'. During the day, we will be taking part in a discovery session called 'Science within the natural world and environment'. The children will be observing the environment and the marshland very closely to see what plants and animals they can see. The trip will also include a boat ride and a walk along the 'treacherous' trail marsh walk, observing the natural habitat.

Please use the checklist below to help ensure that your child is fully equipped to have an educational and enjoyable day. Please can your child bring the following, if they are not already in school:

- Navy jogging bottoms
- Navy fleece
- Navy waterproof (the lightweight jacket if you have one)
- Sun hat (weather dependant preferably Town Close branded)
- Long-lasting sun cream should be applied before coming to school. Children may bring a small named bottle to top up at lunchtime.

It may be an idea for girls to wear their winter pinafore dresses to school on the trip day. These can then be taken off at school and the girls can wear their blue polo shirts with their tracksuit bottoms and a jumper/fleece.

The kitchen staff will be providing the children with a packed lunch and snacks for us to take, inclusive of the necessary dietary requirements. The children will be taking their class water bottles in line with the School policy to avoid single use plastic bottles.

If your child suffers from hay fever, please ensure that they have had an antihistamine before coming to school. Additionally, it is also useful to let your child's class teacher know if they suffer from travel sickness.

Please note that the children are still required to come to school wearing their full school uniform on the day. The children will be wearing their school trainers for the visit and hi-visibility vests will also be worn at all times by the children and adults.
