



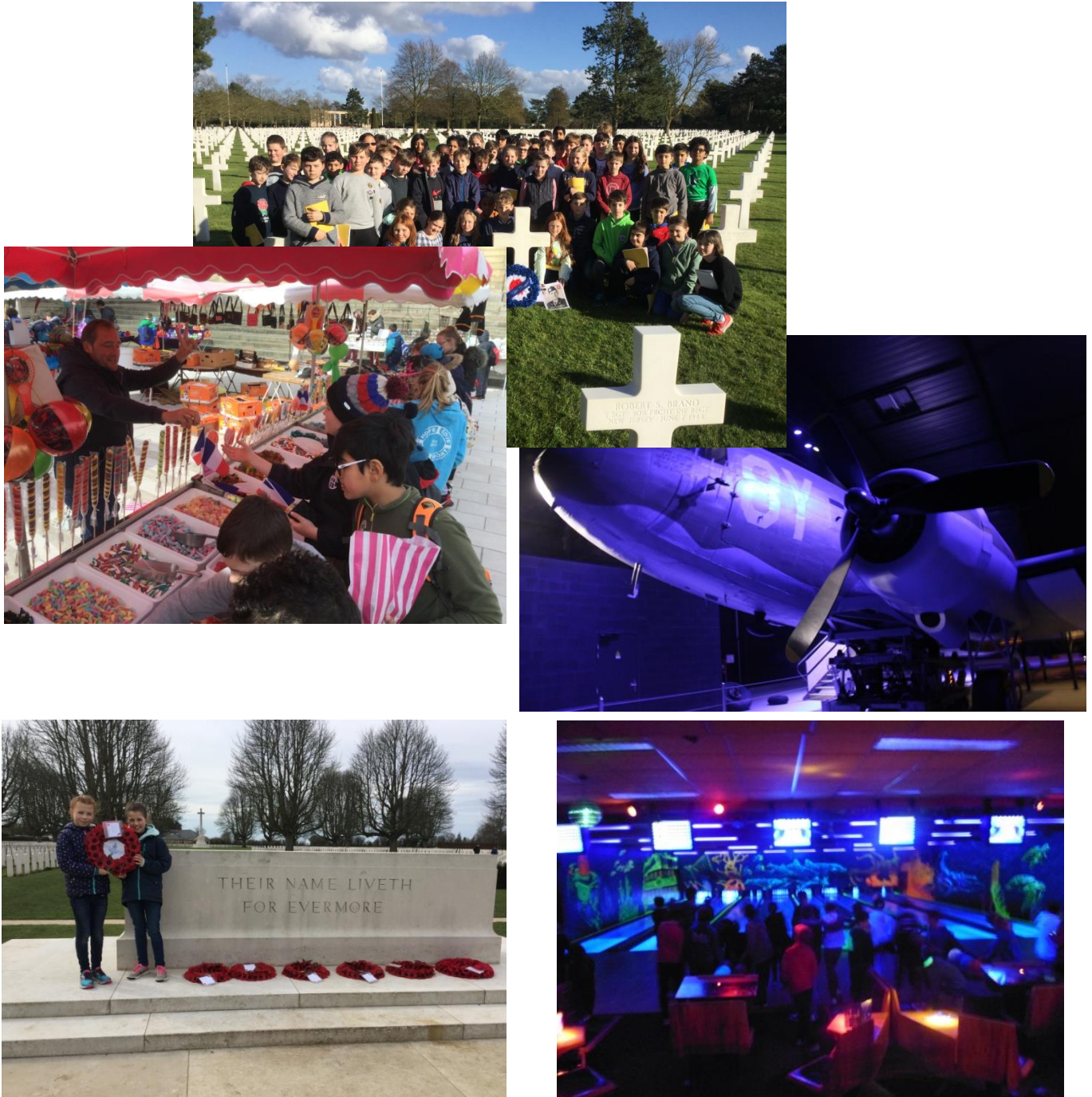
## **Year 6 Humanities Trip March 2020**

Dear Year 5 parents

I am writing to inform you about next year's annual Year 6 residential trip to Normandy, which will take place from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March to Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2020 – the penultimate week of the spring term. No doubt, many of you read about and watched the moving and poignant celebrations in honour of the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of D Day last week. In essence, the trip comprises a study of D Day and the subsequent battle of Normandy as well as celebrating the glorious medieval connection between Normandy and England, Norfolk and Norwich in the form of William the Conqueror, castles, cathedrals, churches and, of course, the world famous Bayeux Tapestry.

In addition to this, there are a number of more relaxed activities planned such as flight simulators, ten-pin bowling, visits to markets, games on the beach, crêpe tasting, quizzes, Dutch auction etc., in order to create a balanced programme for the week, enabling the pupils to embrace different aspects of Normandy's culture. The intention is to view the rich tapestry of history, not just from a British perspective, but to consider it from French, American, Canadian and German viewpoints as well. Equally, we will examine the various events and stories from the perspectives of individual characters, both the famous and the less well known.

Moreover, the trip forms an equally important function, that of providing an excellent opportunity for the children to take further, vital steps towards growing up, taking care of themselves, living alongside others, making decisions and generally becoming more physically, organisationally and emotionally independent.

Accommodation will be in the elegant eighteenth-century Château du Baffy where we have happily stayed before. It has recently been refurbished and specifically caters for school trips. It has a wonderful range of facilities and is set in its own private parkland north of Bayeux.



In terms of the cost; by looking to book in advance, I have been able to secure a discount per child meaning that the cost per pupil will be about £495 (roughly the same cost as the 2019 trip). The cost is **all inclusive** covering transport, accommodation, food and drink, museum entrances, guides, entertainments etc.

The trip is **not compulsory** but generally, there has been full attendance from Year 6 pupils. In order to secure this favourable price structure, I would be very grateful if you would consider the information above, discuss it with your child and return the slip below to the Front Office by **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019 at the latest**, indicating whether or not you would like your child to join the trip.

If you wish your child to join the trip, a deposit of £200 will need to be paid directly to the School Finance Department by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019.
