# ANNUAL INFORMATION

## Enquiries and Entrance Procedures

We are always delighted to show prospective parents around the School. Please contact our Admissions and Marketing Manager to arrange either a personal visit or to confirm a place at one of our open mornings. Pupils normally join the School at three years (Nursery), four years (Reception) and seven years (Year Three) of age. We admit a small number of pupils at Year Two and we also welcome applications at other ages where space permits; further details are available from the Admissions and Marketing Manager.

Parents wishing their child to join the School should complete the attached registration form. Places are allocated following an assessment visit and are always subject to a satisfactory report being received from a child's previous school, where this is relevant.

## Assessment Process

We are academically non-selective. However, there may be circumstances when a child's social and emotional development may inhibit his or her ability to benefit from the curriculum we provide. In circumstances where we do not believe that we can provide appropriately for a child's specific needs, a place may not be offered. Our aim is to be certain that each child will flourish at Town Close School. The assessment process varies depending on the child's age and is outlined below:

- For entry to Nursery and Reception (three to five years of age) children are invited for an informal visit where they are observed undertaking various activities in a relaxed school environment for approximately one hour. Please note that there is an expectation that children will not need to wear nappies
- For entry to Year One (five to six years of age) children are invited to spend half a day at the School and are observed undertaking various activities and general assessments whilst having the opportunity to experience life at the School and to meet new friends
- For entry to Year Two and above (six to thirteen years of age) children are invited to spend the day at the School and to participate fully in the scheduled timetable. The child's reading and non-verbal reasoning are assessed at certain points during the day. Applicants for Years Two to Four meet the Headmaster informally in the classroom, whilst those applying for Years Five to Eight have a slightly more formal interview in the Headmaster's study.

Please note that as part of the assessment process, sometimes a child may be invited to spend additional time at the School in order to gain a clearer picture of their development. **In addition, reports are requested from all Schools/Nursery settings prior to an offer of a place being made.**

## **Acceptance Deposit**

Following the completion of a registration form and once a child has successfully completed their assessment, an offer letter will be sent with a contract and administration booklet. Please return these completed forms with an acceptance deposit of £300 which is refundable once a child has left the School.

## **Admissions Criteria**

We have, and aim to keep, a natural healthy mix both of girls and boys and children with a range of talents and interests. We believe that this reflects much more closely the broad mix of society that children will experience in adult life.

Accordingly we may prioritise some applications by applying the following criteria as even-handedly as possible:

- A balance between boys and girls
- A balance of talents, interests and abilities within a year group
- Priority to children with siblings already at Town Close School
- Priority to children of former pupils of the School.

Thereafter we take into account the date pupils were originally registered on our admissions lists. It is important to note that, in the Nursery, children may join as soon as they are three but priority is always given to those children in their final year before joining Reception.

## **Bursaries**

Our bursary programme is designed to enable those who meet Town Close School's entry criteria, but cannot afford the fees and other costs, to take up a place here. We offer means-tested awards and seek to focus this support on candidates demonstrating a particularly strong need for a Town Close education. Both parents are required to provide proof of their income and assets. The level of support varies according to parental need but can extend to full fee remission in cases of exceptional need.

Bursaries are always offered for 12 months at a time. The family is required to provide fresh information about its circumstances for every year that their child attends the School. Levels of support may vary with fluctuations in income. Bursaries are always conditional on a child exhibiting good behaviour and application.

The School's practice is to allocate available bursary funding on entry. The School's expectation is that parents who do not choose to apply for a bursary at the time that their child is being assessed, will not require financial support throughout the time that their child attends the School, except in wholly unforeseen circumstances.

# FEES AND VARIABLE EXPENSES 2019/2020

## Termly Fees

We try our best to ensure that the majority of costs associated with sending your child to Town Close School are included in our termly fee. For instance, no extra charges are made for lunches, books, non-residential trips or for most after school activities and include a personal accident insurance scheme. The termly fees for the 2019/20 academic year are:

## Individual Music Lessons for Year One to Year Eight

We are fortunate that there are a number of self-employed professional teachers based at Town Close School who can offer tuition on the piano, guitar, voice, violin, cello, flute, clarinet, oboe, saxophone, recorder, trumpet, horn, trombone, euphonium, cornet and drums – subject to them having availability on their lists. We actively encourage as many children as possible to learn to play an instrument as the long-term benefits are without question.

The visiting music teachers undertake to provide 30 lessons per annum divided between three terms – some terms may have 12 lessons and others may only have 8. The fees, however, are spread equally and have been fixed at £190.00 per term.
