

In a shop, coloured pencils are sold in packs. Each pack contains 5 coloured pencils. If the shopkeeper sells 8 packs, how many pencils are sold altogether?

Mrs Bradshaw had 4 children. Each of her children were given 5 chocolate bars. How many chocolate bars did they have altogether?

On holiday, Noah swam 12 metres every day. After 5 days of swimming, how many metres had he swum?

Mary works every day of the week, apart from weekends. She works for 4 hours each day. How many hours will she work in 1 week?

There 5 cars in each queue at pick up time and there are 3 queues. How many cars are there altogether in the playground?

At Town Close nursery, there are 9 teachers. Each teacher cares for 5 children. How many children are there in total?

Biscuits are sold in packs of 6. I buy 5 packs of biscuits. How many biscuits do I have altogether?

Five children in Silver Birch put one of their hands up. How many fingers/thumbs are in the air?

Ben cooked 5 sausages on Monday, another 5 sausages on Wednesday and 5 sausages on Friday. How many sausages did he cook in total?

Jenny got six £5 notes for her birthday. How much money did she have in total?

Which is more:

$$3 \times 5 =$$

Or

$$5 \times 3 =$$

$$8 \times 5 = 80$$
